



What's New

Improvements (See User Guide page # for more information)

- Daily symptom reports sent via SMS weblink now have a more compact weblink resulting in one text message per person (previously 2 messages per person were sent). This will address issue where messages delivered by carriers out of order (Pages 116-117, 125)
- Daily symptom reports accessed by a monitoree via an emailed or SMS texted weblink will now show the monitoree's initials and age on the top of the report. This will improve the reporting experience for a head of household by clearly identifying which household member the report is for (Pages 126)
- Addition of new Contact Tracer and Super User roles (Pages 10,12-13)

Usability and Performance

- Validation of dates during import using criteria applied in the UI and Enrollment Wizard. Please see the data dictionary for allowed date ranges
- Ability to filter History messages by initiator of change (users or Sara Alert System) (Page 29)

Fixes

- Improved notification eligibility logic for households by checking monitoring period of household members in the exposure workflow. This should address reports of heads of households receiving messages longer than expected (Page 118)
- Reduced the time delay during peak reporting period between when a monitoree submits a report and when it appears in the system. This should address reports of a time lag between monitoree report submissions and availability in the system
- Addition of a selectable Null option for Monitoring Plan

- Require select data elements on the Patient resource and various other data validations now applied. See full [API Release Notes](#) for more details.
- Updated error response upon failure of validations shown as a 422 error (Unprocessable Entity) with specific validation error messaging.
- Supports full Assigned Jurisdiction path on the Patient resource in the API. Formatted as a string field extension with values expected to be exactly the same as the Sara Alert format import
