



What's New Improvements

- Added capability to zoom/resize maps in the Analytics summary; made Washington, DC visible.
- Improved formatting of language users see when marking symptom reports as reviewed
- Reduced export generation memory usage (to improve performance)

Fixes

- Fixed issue where closed records that were transferred by a jurisdiction were not appearing on the "Transferred Out" line list
- Fixed issue where edits to non-Boolean symptom report questions were not appearing in record history
- Fixed issue where record history was not always documenting when a monitoree texted "Stop" to opt-out of SMS messages. This did not impact monitorees who text "Stop" in response to a daily report message.
- Removed option to generate .CSV files using custom export to prevent failure of files that exceed current file size limitations. Custom export still supports .XLSX files which are inherently smaller. CSV option will be re-enabled in a future version when exports are consolidated.
