



What's New (User Guide pages in parentheses)

Improvements

- Monitorees will now receive reports in Chinese if their Primary Language is set to Chinese. Chinese is supported for the Telephone Call and E-mailed Web Link Preferred Reporting Methods Only. If a monitoree's Primary Language is set to Chinese, but their Preferred Reporting Method is set to either of the SMS-based methods, they will receive reports in English.
- Users can now record a monitoree's International Phone Number. This field will not be used by the system to send daily reports. (Page 24)
- Users can now identify monitorees who have unenrolled Close Contacts (in their Close Contacts table) using a new Advanced Filter. (Page A-5)

Usability and Performance

- Users now need to enter data in at minimum one of the four Lab Result fields to save a Lab Result (previously a date and result were required). This does not apply to a positive lab result entered during enrollment of an asymptomatic or pre-symptomatic case (which still requires a Specimen Collection Date). (Page 102)
- Minor performance improvements on the backend.

Bug Fixes

- Fixed an issue where the import progress bar did not accurately reflect the percentage of records imported.



User Documentation Updates

- Minor updates only.



API Overall Improvements

- Support writing many additional fields via the API, including all importable fields.
