

Sara Alert Interactive Training Access Instructions



What is the Sara Alert Interactive Training?

The Sara Alert Interactive Training is a set of seven user-specific, guided training modules that provide instruction in how to use the Sara Alert system. The training is free for Sara Alert users, who will receive a certificate once they complete all lessons for their specific role.

Content is tailored to a user's specific role so they will work through only the lessons relevant to their workflows. Depending on their role, a user will learn how to do some or all of the following:

- Understand the Sara Alert workflows and how monitorees report
- Navigate the monitoring dashboards and search for monitorees
- Create, edit, and manage monitoree records
- Import and export records
- Document lab results, vaccinations, and close contacts
- Manage households in Sara Alert
- View jurisdiction analytics
- Manage Sara Alert users



How do I access the Sara Alert Interactive Training?

1. Using a supported browser (Chrome, Edge, or Firefox), navigate to the appropriate webpage based on your Sara Alert user role:

- Click the green box that says Register.
- 3. This will bring you to the "Cart" page (the cost is \$0). Click the green Sign In button.
- 4. If you already have an ASTHO account, you may log in to continue. If not, you need to fill in the information on the right side of the screen under **Create New User** and click on the blue **Create New Account and Sign In** button.
- 5. Once you have created your account and logged in, you will be brought back to the course page. You can then proceed to a Pre-Registration Survey, followed by the lessons. Each individual lesson includes knowledge checks to support your understanding of the material (**Note:** there is a minimum period of time you must spend in each lesson to advance to the subsequent lesson).
- 6. After completing the final lesson, you will receive a course completion certificate.
