Which user types can access the Analytics Summary?



Analyst

- Analyst users can only view the Analytics summary.
- Analyst users do not have access to the Monitoring Dashboards and cannot access monitoree records.

- These users click “Analytics” at the top of their screen to view the Analytics Dashboard.

What data populates the Analytics Summary? What actions can I take?

Data Access

- Summary charts and tables are populated using information from your assigned jurisdiction.
- Maps display the number of active monitorees in the Exposure and Isolation Workflows by state/insular area and county.

Actions

- View and export analytics summary.

What information is displayed in the Analytics summary?

Analytics are generated using data from both the Exposure and Isolation Workflows.

- Monitorees by Reporting Method (Active Records)
- Monitoree Flow Over Time (All Records)
 - Exposure to Case Development
- Epidemiological Summary by Workflow (Active Records)
 - Demographics: Current Age (Years), Sex, Ethnicity, Race, Sexual Orientation
 - Exposure Summary: Risk Factors, Country of Exposure
- Monitorees by Last Date of Exposure in Exposure Workflow (Active Records)
- Monitorees by Symptom Onset date in Isolation Workflow (Active Records)
- State and insular area maps showing active monitorees in the exposure and isolation workflows over time (heat map, with adjustable timeline).

How do I view or export analytics for my jurisdiction?

To View:

- You will be taken directly to the analytics summary upon login.
 - Epidemiological Summary can be viewed as tables (default) or graphs.
 - Users can select the desired time resolution for the Monitorees by Event Date chart.
 - Users can click on a state on the maps to see county-level data for records in their jurisdiction (if county field populated) and select a date from the timeline.

To Export entire dashboard (as an image)— (unavailable using Internet Explorer 11)

- Update page to display desired view (tables, charts, time resolution, date for maps)
- Select “Export Analysis as PNG”
- File will appear in Downloads (depending on system settings)

To Export Complete Country of Exposure Date (as a CSV file):

- Click “Download Data (CSV)” button
